Register Now for the Fall

Registration has begun for next school year, 2021-2022 and classes are filling quickly. Please spread the word to family & friends and ask them to email the preschool office, call or visit our website for an application. **When we receive your completed application and \$40 non-refundable application fee (per family) we will put your child's name on a temporary class roster. The roster will become permanent as soon as there are enough children to run the class. Reminder that classes will remain smaller in size this fall, so don't wait to register.** You will receive the medical forms packet upon registering and they are due by August 1 along with the first month's tuition. You may hand it in anytime it is completed.

The class choices for the 2021-2022 school year are as follows:

Toddlers: 2-day: \$116/month OR 3-day: \$174/month

Children DO NOT need to be potty-trained to enter this class
(Will turn 2 by September 30, 2021)

3's: 2-day: \$168/month OR 3-day: \$252/month

Children must be potty-trained to enter this class.
(Will turn 3 by September 30, 2021)

4's: 3-day: \$252/month OR 4-day: \$336/month
(Will turn 4 by September 30, 2021)

Pre-K: 4-day: \$336/month OR 5-day: \$420/month
(Will turn 5 by January 31, 2022)

Kindergarten

Classes will run 4 days a week from 9-11:30. Children must be potty-trained and ages 3 – 5 (Pre-K). Children will need to bring a snack and drink.
