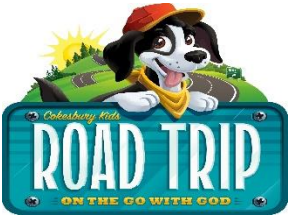
THANK YOU to everyone who attended the events, donated supplies and supported our fundraisers this school year! We are excited to purchase new toys, curriculum and more for the Preschool!

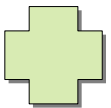

Anti-Bullying Policy At Robeson Lutheran

Robeson Lutheran Church has instituted the following Anti-Bullying Policy regarding bullying behavior that might occur during any of our events for youth at the church.

If a child is heard or observed verbally bullying another child, an attempt will be made to find peaceful and lasting resolution, however, if the offending behavior continues, the instigating child's parent will be **contacted to pick his/her child up promptly** and a follow-up conversation **will be required** to determine whether the child may continue to participate for rest of the event for this year.

If a child is heard or observed physically bullying another child, the instigating child's parent will be **immediately contacted and asked to pick his/her child up promptly**. This will result in the child's immediate withdrawal from the rest of the event for this year.

This policy is supported by the entire staff of Robeson Lutheran Church, who strongly believes that the church should be a safe place for all God's children, and while we are loath to turn anyone away; we will not stand by while bullying endangers the emotional, physical, psychological, and spiritual health of our children (both the victim and the victimizer).

It is our fervent prayer that all parents will seek to instill a healthy respect for the rights and feelings of others in their children, and teach them positive social skills that help to build up the community around them.
